## University System of Georgia Freshman Admission Requirements



SAT/ACT, HSGPA, and Freshman Index Requirements

The University System of Georgia (USG), comprised of 26 higher education institutions, including 4 research universities, 4 comprehensive universities, 9 state universities and 9 state colleges, provides many opportunities for students to pursue their educational goals. This document provides the freshman admission requirements for each USG college and university. In addition to these requirements, freshman applicants must satisfy the Required High School Curriculum (RHSC) as outlined on the USG's Staying on Course document and graduate from a high school accredited by a regional accrediting association (such as the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools) or the Georgia Accrediting Commission or from a public school regulated by a school system and state department of education. Students are encouraged to contact the Admission Office of their college or university of interest to learn more about admission criteria, required documentation, and deadlines.

## **FOOTNOTES**

<sup>1</sup> The SAT FI formula uses the Old (pre-March 2016) SAT. New (March 2016 or later) SAT scores are converted to the comparable old SAT scores using the <u>College Board conversion tables</u>. New SAT Reading test scores are converted to comparable old SAT Critical Reading section scores and new SAT Math scores are converted to comparable old SAT Math section scores.

The SAT FI formula is:

500 x (HSGPA) + Old SAT Critical Reading section score + Old SAT Math section score

The ACT FI formula is:

500 x (HSGPA) + (ACT Composite x 42) + 88

<sup>2</sup>The High School GPA (HSGPA) is calculated using the 17 units of the Required High School Curriculum (RHSC) as outlined on the USG's Staying on Course document. The HSGPA is calculated on an alpha four-point scale. Numerical grades provided on high school transcripts are converted to letter grades based on the conversion table provided by the high school. The letter grades are converted to quality points as follows:

A = 4

B = 3

C = 2

D = 1

F = 0
